**DIRECTIONS TO THE TRIAL:** 2115 Curtis Road, Falcon, CO 80831

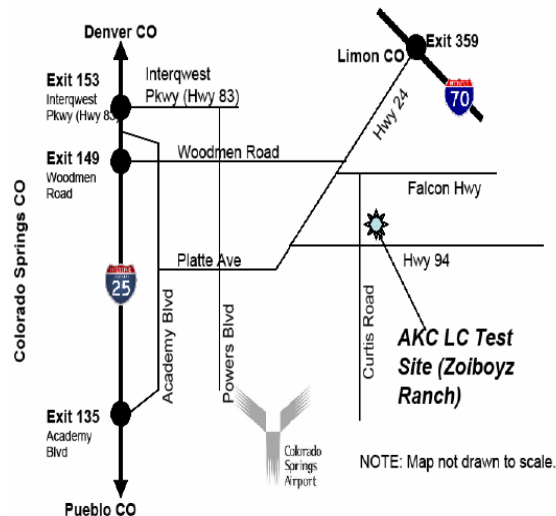
### From the North at intersection of Hwy 24 and Falcon Hwy

- Turn left (east) onto Falcon Hwy ~3.5 miles to flashing yellow (Curtis Rd)
- Turn right (south) onto Curtis Road for 4.2 miles to mailbox 2115
- Turn left to Zoiboyz Ranch (NOTE: This will be the 2nd driveway on left after Davis Road.

Ignore small house near Curtis Road; go on up the hill to the house surrounded by white fence. You've gone too far down Curtis if you come to Hwy 94 and a traffic signal.

### From the South heading north/east on Hwy 24 at Hwy 94

- Exit right (east) on Hwy 94
- 7.5 miles to Curtis road at stop light. (signs for Dragonman's and Schriever Base)
- Turn left (north) on Curtis road.
- 2 miles to 2115, Zoiboyz Ranch. Right onto driveway

**CAT DEFINED:** CAT is an outdoor pass/fail event open to all dogs. CAT is based on the fundamentals of the sport of Lure Coursing where two different sized courses, 300 yards or 600 yards are used depending on a dog's height. Dogs run singly and are required to complete the course with enthusiasm and without interruption within a maximum amount of time.

**300 Yard Course.** This distance is for dogs **shorter than 12 inches** at the withers and/or brachycephalic ("flatfaced") dogs. A **veteran dog 12" or less may run 200 yards** at the owner's discretion. A dog must complete this course in less than 1½ minutes.

**600 Yard Course.** This distance is used for all dogs that do not run the 300-yard course. A **veteran dog may run 400 yards** at the owner's discretion. A dog must complete this course in less than 2 minutes.

### Eligibility:

- Coursing Ability Tests are open to all dogs **at least 12 months of age** that are individually **registered** with the AKC, recorded in the Foundation Stock Service (FSS) program, individually registered with a foreign or domestic registry organization whose pedigrees are acceptable for AKC registration, dogs granted a Purebred Alternative Listing (PAL) number, dogs with AKC Limited or Conditional Registration, or dogs enrolled in the AKC Canine Partners program.
- Dogs with breed disqualifications and monorchid/cryptorchid dogs **are** eligible to participate.
- Females in season may not enter. Refunds for pre-entered females in season.
- A dog may enter only once per event. (An event is defined by an event number.)

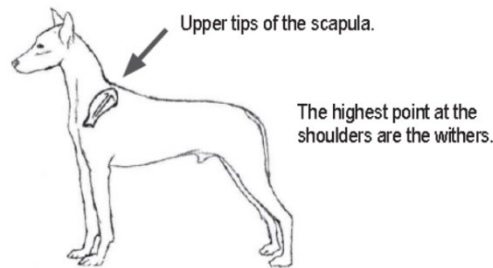
### Conditions of Entry:

- In the opinion of the inspection committee, any entry found to be **lame, unfit to participate** or a **female in season** shall not be allowed to enter and entry fees shall be refunded in full.
- **You may not call or direct your dogs while they are coursing unless told to do so by the Huntmaster.**
- Dogs that are physically challenged due to loss of limbs are eligible to enter and should be given the same consideration by the inspection committee as four-legged dogs. A dog that exhibits a state of well-being at the time of inspection, shows no signs of physical discomfort, and in the opinion of the inspection committee appears to physically have the potential to safely complete the course, is to be considered fit to participate.
- **COMMUNICABLE DISEASES.** No dog with a communicable disease shall be on the event grounds or premises. Exhibitors should follow their veterinarian's recommendations to ensure that their dogs are free of internal and external parasites, any communicable disease, and have appropriate vaccinations.
- **Collars/muzzles:** Dogs may wear any collar except a choker collar, a collar with prongs or an electronic training collar. The collar should be snug to minimize the chances of getting hung up on something during the run. The RMHA will require tags hanging from the collar to be secured (taped to the collar) to ensure the dog's safety. Dogs may be muzzled at the owner's discretion. If a muzzle is used, they must not have sharp, hard edges and must be of a basket type that allow the dog to open its mouth to pant and breath freely.
- Any dog that displays aggressive behavior during test or trials hours will be excused for that day.

- A penalty of \$10 will be assessed for any loose dog not competing in the course in progress.
- Persons exhibiting conduct detrimental to AKC, RMHA, any dog(s), or other person(s) will be asked to leave the trial site and appropriate disciplinary action will be filed with the American Kennel Club (AKC) – please conduct yourselves accordingly.
- Children must always be under control of their parents or guardians.
- No Flexi-leads are allowed on the test grounds.

### **Height of dog**

If necessary, the Inspection Committee is responsible for measuring dogs to determine their height at the withers. The withers is the highest point of the shoulders right behind the base of the neck.



### **Equipment:**

We will use battery powered electric motors with a continuous loop. Lure will be white and/or black trash bags.

### **Field:**

Terrain is mowed pasture grass with uneven ground with some bushes/plants such as yucca and possible cactus. Elevation of the course site is about 6800 feet and both days' course layouts include up and downhill slopes. The perimeter of the Zoiboyz ranch is fully fenced.

### **Course:**

600 yards for dogs 12" or over  
 400 yards for dogs 12" or over and over 7 years old  
 300 yards for dogs under 12" or brachycephalic  
 200 yards for dogs under 12" or brachycephalic and over 7 years old

### **General Information:**

- RMHA recommends that your dogs be in good physical condition before attempting the course.
- This course site is at 6800 ft altitude, contains hills, some plants, possible gopher holes and cactus. If you and your dog are not acclimated to high altitude, you may feel its affects.
- Bring water and shade for your dogs – none is on the field
- Pick up after your dog and yourself.
- Clean up and carry out all trash.
- No fires allowed! No smoking outside of vehicles. Conditions are quite dry.
- Weather in Colorado is unpredictable – bring rain gear, layers of clothing, hat, gloves, sunglasses, and sunscreen.
- A baby pool will be available to cool dogs.
- Some first aid supplies will be available at the field; however, you should be advised to bring your own first aid kit for you AND your dog
- A \$25 fee will be assessed for any returned checks
- We will have an earlier roll call and inspection for hounds of the field trial committee, working RMHA members, lure operators, and judges.
- Port-a-pot will be available on site.
- ALL HANDLERS MUST BE PRESENT FOR ROLL CALL, INSPECTION AND ANNOUNCEMENTS. Test 2 roll call will be 30 minutes after completion of Test 1 each day.
- NO ONE will be allowed on the field without the express permission of the field chairman, except the appointed field committee.
- Dogs must be leashed at all times except when running - **strictly enforced.**
- No meals are provided for exhibitors. Please pack your own snacks, drinks, meals.
