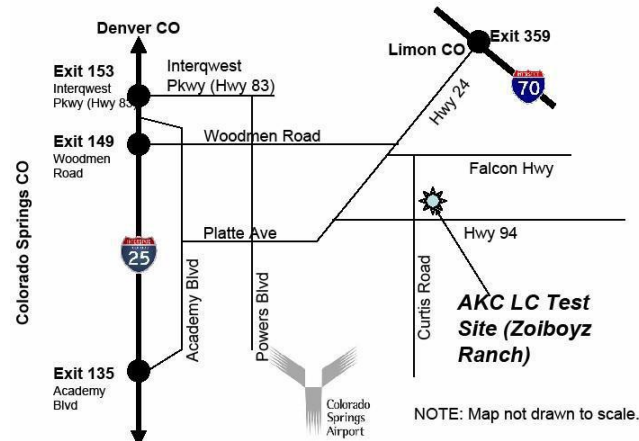

DIRECTIONS TO THE TRIAL:

FROM THE SOUTH

1. From I-25 North, take exit 135 Academy Blvd
2. North on Academy 5.8 miles to East Platte Ave
3. Right on E. Platte 3.7 miles to Hwy 94 (direction Shriever AFB)
4. Right on Hwy 94 7.5 miles to Curtis Road (2nd light on Hwy 94)
5. Left on Curtis Road 1.9 miles to mailbox 2115 and Zoiboyz Ranch on right—it is the house surrounded by white fence on the hill. (Ignore the small house in front near Curtis Road. You've gone too far north on Curtis if you come to Falcon Hwy and a blinking red traffic signal.)

FROM THE NORTH

1. From I-25 South, take exit 153 Interquest Parkway/Hwy 83
2. Go on Hwy 83 to South Powers Blvd
3. Turn right on South Powers Blvd
4. Stay on Powers to Woodmen Road Exit
5. Go left (east) ~12 miles on Woodmen to its end at Hwy 24
6. Go right on Hwy 24 0.5 miles to Meridian
7. Go left on Meridian to STOP sign at Falcon Hwy
8. Turn left onto Falcon Hwy ~3 miles to flashing yellow (Curtis Rd)
9. Turn right (south) onto Curtis Road for 4.4 miles to mailbox 2115.
10. Turn left to Zoiboyz Ranch (NOTE: This will be the 2nd driveway on left after Davis Road. Ignore small house near Curtis Road; go on up the hill to the house surrounded by white fence. You've gone too far down Curtis if you come to Hwy 94 and a traffic signal)

ROLL CALL: 8:30 A.M. for AM Tests. PM Roll Call 30 minutes after completion of AM Tests.

Any dog not present at Roll Call will be scratched and entry fee will not be refunded.

PayPal Instructions: Please scan your signed entries and email to zoiboyz@zoiboyz.com. Make payments via PayPal to rmhounds@gmail.com. You must add \$2 per transaction if paying by PayPal. Please refer to this trial and the dogs you are entering.

Conditions of Entry:

All dogs will be checked for breed disqualifications. Bitches in season and lame hounds will be excused and their entries refunded. Muzzles are not required; it is the owners' responsibility to determine if their dog should be muzzled. Dogs must be one year or older on the day of the test or trial. Any dog that displays aggressive behavior during test or trials hours will be excused for that day. A penalty of \$10 will be assessed for any loose hound not competing in the course in progress. Exhibitors should follow their veterinarians' recommendation to assure their dogs are free of internal and external parasites, any communicable diseases, and have appropriate vaccinations. Persons exhibiting conduct detrimental to AKC, RMHA any dog(s), other person(s) will be asked to leave the trial site AND appropriate disciplinary action will be filed with the American Kennel Club (AKC) – please conduct yourselves accordingly. Children must be under control of their parents or guardians at all times.

Eligibility:

Coursing Ability Tests are open to all dogs at least 12 months of age that are individually registered with the AKC, recorded in the Foundation Stock Service (FSS) program, individually registered with a foreign or domestic registry organization whose pedigrees are acceptable for AKC registration, dogs granted a Purebred Alternative Listing (PAL) number, dogs with AKC Limited or Conditional Registration, or dogs enrolled in the AKC Canine Partners program. Dogs with breed disqualifications and monorchid/cryptorchid dogs are eligible to participate. Females in season may not enter. A dog may enter only once per event. (An event is defined by an event number.)

Ribbons & Prizes:

Orange flat ribbon for completion of Test.
Orange rosette for earning a Title.

Equipment:

We will use battery powered electric motors with a continuous loop. Lure will be white and/or black trash bags.

Field:

Terrain is mowed field grass with uneven ground. There is possibility of cactus. Elevation of the course site is about 6800 feet and both days' course layouts include up and downhill slopes. The perimeter of the Zoiboyz ranch is fully fenced.

General Information:

- RMHA recommends that your hounds be in good physical condition before attempting the course.
- Bring water and shade for your dogs – none is on the field
- Pick up after your dog and yourself
- Please include a phone number on your entries in case of bad weather
- No fires allowed! If you must smoke, please do so inside of your vehicle. Conditions are quite dry and even an errant cigarette ash could spark a fire
- Weather in Colorado is unpredictable – from very warm temperatures to snow – bring rain gear, layers of clothing, hat, gloves, sunglasses, and sunscreen.
- Some first aid supplies will be available at the field; however, you should be advised to bring your own first aid kit for you AND your dog
- A \$25 fee will be assessed for any returned checks
- We will have an earlier roll call and inspection for hounds of the field trial committee, working RMHA members, lure operators, and judges.

- Port-a-pot will be available on site
- **ALL HANDLERS MUST BE PRESENT FOR ROLL CALL, INSPECTION AND ANNOUNCEMENTS**
- Any dog not present 5 minutes after roll call will be considered absent and will be scratched (no refunds)
- All dogs will be inspected prior to roll call
- Each entry will be examined at inspection. Bitches in season and lame dogs will be excused. Entry fee will be refunded for dogs excused during inspection, for bitches in season or lameness
- All dogs running on the 600-yard course will run first followed by dogs running on 400-yard course, then 300, and 200. Course size is determined by size and age of dog (veteran status).
- **NO ONE** will be allowed on the field without the express permission of the field chairman, except the appointed field committee.
- Control of dogs strictly enforced, on leash at all times except when running.
- Clean up and carry out all trash.
- Please pick up all dog feces and remove with trash or put in receptacle provided at site.
- No flexi leads on the field for you and your dog's safety

How to use Entry Forms

1. Complete a separate entry form for each dog.
2. Enter your dog's AKC number (PAL/ILP and Canine Partners numbers)
3. Mail the completed form and check made payable to XXXX to the field trial secretary by the closing date (April 18, 2018) Or bring the completed form and check the day of the Tests, by the closing time.
4. Veteran dogs (defined as dogs over 7 years) are required to run only 2/3 of the specified course distance for their height.

INCOMPLETE, UNSIGNED, CONDITIONAL OR UNPAID ENTRIES WILL NOT BE ACCEPTED. ENTRIES WILL NOT BE ACKNOWLEDGED. PLEASE INDICATE ON THE FORM IF YOU ARE ENTERING A VETERAN. A SEPARATE FORM MUST BE USED FOR EACH EVENT AND EACH DOG.
