DIRECTIONS FROM:

NORTH via I-25 (Ft. Collins, Longmont, Loveland)

- Take I-25 south to exit 223 for 120th Ave/CO-128 W
- Turn left, heading east and drive for 6.3 miles
- Turn left on Brighton Road and drive NE for .8 miles
- Turn left on Henderson road and drive .6 miles to Park Entrance
- Turn Right on Park Blvd. and drive .4 miles past the domed building on your left.
- The Picnic Pavilion will be on your right/east side

NORTH via US 85 (Greeley)

- Take US-85 South towards 124th Ave in Brighton
- Turn right heading west for .6 miles to the stop sign
- Continue as 124th becomes Henderson and drive .6 miles to Park Entrance
- Turn Right on Park Blvd. and drive .4 miles past the domed building on your left.
- The Picnic Pavilion will be on your right/east side

EAST via I-70

- Take I-70 West towards Denver
- Take Exit 279A for I-270 Fort Collins-Boulder
- Drive 4.9 miles to exit 1 and follow signs to I-76 East
- Continue .5 miles to exit for I-76 E/Fort Morgan
- Drive on I-76 for 5.8 Miles to exit 12 for US-85 North
- Continue on US-85 for 3.2 miles to 124th Avenue
- Turn left heading west for .6 miles to the stop sign
- Continue as 124th becomes Henderson and drive .6 miles to Park Entrance
- Turn Right on Park Blvd. and drive .4 miles past the domed building on your left.
- The Picnic Pavilion will be on your right/east side

WEST via I-70

- Take I-70 East towards Denver
- Take Exit 274 I-25 North Ft. Collins
- Drive 1.8 miles to exit 216A and exit into I-76 E toward Fort Morgan
- Drive on I-76 for 7.1 Miles to exit 12 (left-lane exit) for US-85 North
- Continue on US-85 for 3.2 miles to 124th Avenue
- Turn left heading west for .6 miles to the stop sign
- Continue as 124th becomes Henderson and drive .6 miles to Park Entrance
- Turn Right on Park Blvd. and drive .4 miles past the domed building on your left.
- The Picnic Pavilion will be on your right/east side

Check-in and inspection from 9:00-11:00 AM each day. Dogs not checked in by 11:00 AM will be scratched and entry fees will NOT be refunded. Bitches in season and lame hounds at inspection will be excused and their entry fee refunded.

Day of trial entries close at Noon if the 100 entry limit has not been met previously.

Exhibitors should follow veterinarian's recommendations to assure their dogs are free of internal & external parasites, any communicable diseases & have appropriate vaccinations.

Running order will be determined as each exhibitor arrives and their dog is inspected.

Test hours 9 AM – 2 PM each day

ENTRY FEES

Pre-entry fees \$20.00 for each entry (per dog per test) 100 entry limit each day (NO standby dogs will be allowed.)

Day of Test Entries \$25.00 per each entry, and will close at Noon at the Field Trial Secretary's table (Day of Test Entries Accepted as space allows).

Ribbons/Awards

A light blue participation ribbon will be awarded to each dog that completes the 100-yard run. Light blue rosettes for dogs that earn a new title!!

ELIGIBLE DOGS

Fast CAT events are open to all dogs at least 12 months of age that are individually registered with the AKC, recorded in the Foundation Stock Service (FSS) program, individually registered with a foreign or domestic registry organization whose pedigrees are acceptable for AKC registration, dogs granted a Purebred Alternative Listing (PAL) number, dogs with AKC Limited or Conditional Registration, or dogs enrolled in the AKC Canine Partners program. Dogs with breed disqualifications and monorchid/cryptorchid dogs are eligible to participate. Females in season may not participate. Refunds will be given for lameness or in-season females.

RMHA Fast CAT Test Rules and information

- ALL DOGS RUN AT OWNERS SOLE RISK
- All entries must be 12 months of age or older on the day of the test.
- Dogs will NOT be required to wear muzzles
- White and/or black plastic bags will be used for the lure.
- Dogs that are overweight and/or out of condition may be at greater risk for injury and exhaustion. The Inspection Committee has the authority to disallow a dog's entry into a test for lack of condition, and in such instances, applicable entry fees will be refunded.
- All AKC Rules regarding sportsmanship and conduct apply.
- This is a rain-or-shine outdoor event. Please plan accordingly.
- Please bring your own shade/rain cover, chairs and water.
- Manual timers will be used. An electric, continuous loop, plastic strip lure machine will be used.
- Restrooms are on site
- Dogs must be on lead or crated unless running.
- A \$5 fine/per dog per occurrence will be assessed for any loose dog on the field not competing or for not picking up after your dog.
- You are responsible for controlling your dog(s) and children.
- Each dog requires an individual entry form for one or both events in which it is entered. Entries will not be accepted without fees, signatures, or the "Agreement" found on the Official AKC Entry Form. One form may be used per dog for entering both days.
- Bitches in season and lame dogs will be excused. Entry fees will be refunded.
- The Starter is responsible for field safety and therefore he/she is in complete charge of all dogs and handlers on the field. In service to this responsibility, he/she has the authority to stop the lure in any potentially dangerous situation and signal the handler to retrieve a testing dog.
- Dogs should be warmed up before and cooled down after running.

No entry fees will be refunded if the event cannot be started or completed by reason of riots, civil disturbances, fire, extreme and/or dangerous weather conditions, an act of God, public emergency, act of a public enemy, strikes or any other cause beyond the control of the Club or its members and representatives.

ABOUT FAST CAT

Fast CAT is a timed straight 100-yard dash for dogs.

Dogs are held at the start line and the coursing lure is activated prompting the dog to follow chasing it to the finish line and into a catch pen. The course is completely fenced and dogs are run individually.

- A. The dog's time to complete the 100 yard dash is converted into MPHs using the formula below, rounded to the nearest hundredth of a mile:

204.545 / Dog's Time = MPH

Example: The dog's time is 8.14 seconds.
 $204.54 / 8.14 = 25.13$ MPH

B. A handicap system is applied to a dog's MPH to determine the number of points earned. The handicap system is based on the height of the dog at its withers:

- 18" or greater = handicap is 1.0.
- 12" up to less than 18" = handicap is 1.5.
- Below 12" = handicap is 2.0.

C. Points = mph multiplied by the dog's handicap

Titles are earned at specific point levels and the highest suffix may appear after the dog's name:

BCAT = 150 points

DCAT = 500 points

FCAT = 1,000 points

FCAT# = Each additional 500 points

Top 20 by Breed by Year: The AKC Fast CAT website will feature the Top 20 Fastest Dogs by Breed by Year national standings. The standings will be updated as event results are processed.

****RULE CHANGE – NOVEMBER 2018****

AKC has taken a lot of the Exhibitors input and updated the rules a few times over 2018. One of the biggest discussed is the behavior of the exhibitors while their dog is running. The following is from a letter from AKC regarding Regulation Updates in November of 2018. You can review ALL of the regulations at: <https://www.akc.org/sports/coursing/fast-cat/regulations/>

Section 14. Conduct of Handlers. Handlers are not permitted to run down the 100-yard course with a dog during its run. If the course is fenced, this includes both inside or outside the fence. Handlers shall simply release the dog in the starting box and may not run with the dog within the starting box. Handlers may run within the catchment area as their dog is running the course but may not cross the finish line. Cheering, clapping, calling your dog's name, whistling and waving your arms from the end of the course or the start area is allowed. Noise making devices such as whistles, duck calls, electronic calls or other items of this nature are not permitted. The use of toys, treats, flags or other items of this nature are not permitted while the dog is running the 100-yard course, however they may be used after the dog has crossed the finish line to assist in catching the dog. Should a situation arise where the application of this Regulation is open for interpretation, the event committee shall decide how it will be handled. An explanation shall be submitted to the AKC along with the event results.
