**Check-in from 9:00-12:00 Noon each day.** Dogs not checked in by 12:00 Noon will be scratched and entry fees will NOT be refunded. Bitches in season and lame hounds at inspection will be excused and their entry fee refunded.

Day of trial entries close at 2:00 PM if the 70 dog entry limit per test has not been met.

Exhibitors should follow veterinarian's recommendations to assure their dogs are free of internal & external parasites, any communicable diseases & have appropriate vaccinations.

Running order will be in the general order you arrive to check in.

Test hours 9 AM – 3 PM each day

**ENTRY FEES - Pre-entry fees** \$20.00 for each entry (per dog per test) with an entry limit each day of 70 dogs per test.

**Day of Test** Entries \$25.00 per each entry, and will close at 2:00 PM at the Field Trial Secretary's table (Day of Test Entries Accepted as space allows).  
A stand-by list up to 15 dogs will be created and these dogs will be allowed to run if time permits.

### **Ribbons/Awards**

A light blue participation ribbon will be awarded to each dog that completes the 100-yard run. Light blue rosettes for dogs that earn a new title!!

### **ELIGIBLE DOGS**

Fast CAT events are open to all dogs at least 12 months of age that are individually registered with the AKC, recorded in the Foundation Stock Service (FSS) program, individually registered with a foreign or domestic registry organization whose pedigrees are acceptable for AKC registration, dogs granted a Purebred Alternative Listing (PAL) number, dogs with AKC Limited or Conditional Registration, or dogs enrolled in the AKC Canine Partners program. Dogs with breed disqualifications and monorchid/cryptorchid dogs are eligible to participate. Females in season may not participate. Refunds will be given for lameness or in-season females.

### **RMHA Fast CAT Test Rules and information**

- ALL DOGS RUN AT OWNERS SOLE RISK
- All entries must be 12 months of age or older on the day of the test.
- Dogs will NOT be required to wear muzzles
- White and/or black plastic bags will be used for the lure.
- Dogs that are overweight and/or out of condition may be at greater risk for injury and exhaustion. The Inspection Committee has the authority to disallow a dog's entry into a test for lack of condition, and in such instances, applicable entry fees will be refunded.
- All AKC Rules regarding sportsmanship and conduct apply.
- This is a rain-or-shine outdoor event. Please plan accordingly.
- Please bring your own shade/rain cover, chairs and water.
- Manual timers will be used. An electric, continuous loop, plastic strip lure machine will be used.
- Restrooms are on site
- Dogs must be on lead or crated unless running.
- A \$5 fine/per dog per occurrence will be assessed for any loose dog on the field not competing or for not picking up after your dog.
- You are responsible for controlling your dog(s) and children.
- Each dog requires an individual entry form for one or both events in which it is entered. Entries will not be accepted without fees, signatures, or the "Agreement" found on the Official AKC Entry Form. One form may be used per dog for entering both days.
- Bitches in season and lame dogs will be excused. Entry fees will be refunded.
- The Starter is responsible for field safety and therefore he/she is in complete charge of all dogs and handlers on the field. In service to this responsibility, he/she has the authority to stop the lure in any potentially dangerous situation and signal the handler to retrieve a testing dog.
- Dogs should be warmed up before and cooled down after running.

No entry fees will be refunded if the event cannot be started or completed by reason of riots, civil disturbances, fire, extreme and/or dangerous weather conditions, an act of God, public emergency, act of a public enemy, strikes or any other cause beyond the control of the Club or its members and representatives.

## ABOUT FAST CAT

Fast CAT is a timed straight 100-yard dash for dogs.

Dogs are held at the start line and the coursing lure is activated prompting the dog to follow chasing it to the finish line and into a catch pen. The course is completely fenced and dogs are run individually.

A. The dog's time to complete the 100 yard dash is converted into MPHs using the formula below, rounded to the nearest hundredth of a mile:

### 204.545 / Dog's Time = MPH

Example: The dog's time is 8.14 seconds.

$$204.54 / 8.14 = 25.13 \text{ MPH}$$

B. A handicap system is applied to a dog's MPH to determine the number of points earned. The handicap system is based on the height of the dog at its withers:

- 18" or greater = handicap is 1.0.
- 12" up to less than 18" = handicap is 1.5.
- Below 12" = handicap is 2.0.

C. Points = mph multiplied by the dog's handicap

Titles are earned at specific point levels and the highest suffix may appear after the dog's name:

BCAT = 150 points

DCAT = 500 points

FCAT = 1,000 points

FCAT# = Each additional 500 points

**Top 20 by Breed by Year:** The AKC Fast CAT website will feature the Top 20 Fastest Dogs by Breed by Year national standings. The standings will be updated as event results are processed.

## Entering & Procedures

RMHA is running TWO TESTS per day concurrently, with four tests over the weekend: Test #1 and #2 are on Saturday with Test #3 and Test #4 on Sunday.

The tests you enter MUST BE SPECIFIED ON YOUR ENTRY FORM.

Additionally, your dog's height at the withers MUST BE ON THE FORM.

The AKC fillable entry form is attached to the premium. If you cannot fill it out, you will need to print and complete by hand. Scan and send your entry and pay via PayPal.

If you want to only enter one test per day, circle TEST#1 and TEST#3. If you want to enter both tests on Saturday, circle TEST#1 and TEST#2. IF you have questions, contact the Secretary.

If the tests are full, NO gate entries will be taken until noon, and only then if there is space available.

If you Pre-Enter, you must check in at the "CHECK IN" table between 9AM and Noon. This does not mean you have to run then. Once you check in, you will be given your card for each test you entered that day. These cards are your dog's ticket to run! Dogs not checked in by 12:00 Noon will be scratched and entry fees will NOT be refunded. This allows us to take gate entries until the limit per test is reached.

When you are ready to run, you will need to approach the "INSPECTION" area and present ONE of your cards between 9AM and 3PM. Once your dog passes inspection, a stamp will be placed on your card. If your dog is determined to be lame during the inspection, a refund will be given. You will then approach the Secretary where he will put your dog's name on the "BOARD" for the running order. When your name is reached, The Huntmaster will call the dog where you will present your stamped card for verification. Your dog will then blaze a trail down the 100-yard track!

If you entered a second test for that day, you need to return to the "INSPECTION" table between 9AM and 3PM and get your 2<sup>nd</sup> card stamped after your dog has been inspected again. Get the dog's name on the "BOARD" and your dog will blaze a second trail!
